POWER CUBE 9000 is an aluminium alloy housed portable power bank with built-in Lightning connector to charge iPhone 6, iPhone 6 Plus and other Lightning powered iPod, iPhone and iPad. You can use the USB output port to charge most mobile devices. It supports charging two devices at the same time.

Charge mobile device

1. Direct plug in the Lightning connector to charge iPod, iPhone & iPad.

2. Use the USB output port to charge most mobile devices (except eg. Nokia and RiM) via their original charging cable. The included Micro USB charging cable can be used to charge Micro USB powered devices.

3. After connected to your device, please press the power button to turn on Power Cube.





The recharge time may vary depending on the power source you're using.
